Bordewich Bray Dress Code

Update 3/17/2020

Below is an outline of Bordewich Bray's dress code. To promote an atmosphere of learning, the following dress code will be enforced:

- Pants, shorts, leggings, sweatpants, athletic wear and skirts must be fitted at the waist and free from large holes. Shorts, dresses, and skirts must reach a student's fingertips when arms are extended alongside their body. Tights, leggings, and knee socks may be worn under shorts, skirts or dresses.
- Spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, halter tops, tube tops, and muscle shirts are not permitted. Straps on tank tops and dresses should be at least two inches wide. Students are allowed to wear hooded sweatshirts indoors, but are not permitted to wear the hoods up while in the school building. Hoods and hats may be worn while outdoors.
- For the safety of all our students, students may not wear gang-related clothing or clothing with symbols, pins, or other paraphernalia which advertise controlled substances or display inappropriate or violent words or pictures, or illegal substances for this age group (such as smoking, alcohol, marijuana, or vaping).
- Clothing may not be see-through and students may not wear underwear as outwear.
- Students are no longer required to wear polo shirts and pants of specific colors. Instead, students may wear colors and patterns of their choosing as long as it follows the requirements above.
- Students must wear shoes with a solid sole. No shoes with wheels (such as Heely brand) may be worn on campus. No flip-flops, open toed shoes or slippers may be worn. Sandals must be closed toed and must be secured with a solid strap around the heel/ankle.
- For safety concerns, no large drop/hoop earrings or spikes may be worn during the school day. Belts may be worn, but can not be adorned with spikes that could potentially cause a safety issue.
- Lastly, students may not wear make-up to school unless it has been approved by administration for specific events.
